



Conditions Of Entry

- a. Non-marking sports shoes must be worn at all times. No one can walk on the court's floor in black soled shoes, high heels, work boots, gumboots or any other footwear that is likely to mark the floor surface. Staff may request the removal of incorrect footwear prior to entry.
- b. The Facility Manager has the right to refuse any booking that they deem may cause damage to the court floor.
- c. A shirt must be worn at all times.
- d. Cameras are not permitted in the changing rooms.
- e. No chewing gum can be consumed in the Centre and no food can be consumed on the courts floor.
- f. No drinks, apart from water, can be consumed on the courts floor.
- g. No alcohol can be consumed inside, or on the grounds, of the Centre. Intoxicated persons are not permitted in the Centre – the Facility Manager has the right to exclude anyone they believe is intoxicated.
- h. The Centre is a smoke free environment. No smoking (including vaping) inside, or on the grounds, of the Centre.
- i. No cooking in, or beside, the Centre unless approved by the Facility Manager.
- j. No markings can be placed on the courts floor unless approved by the Facility Manager.
- k. No chairs, stools or tables on the courts floor unless approved by the Facility Manager.
- l. No items can be stuck to/attached to any part of the Centre unless approved by the Facility Manager.
- m. No crockery or glasses on the courts floor.
- n. No persons, belongings or equipment, can block any fire exits.
- o. No animals inside the Centre, apart from guide dogs.
- p. No bikes, scooters or skateboards are permitted into the centre and must be secured to the bike racks provided.
- q. No strollers or prams on the court floor.
- r. All equipment borrowed by the Hirer must be placed back in the storage space provided following the instructions displayed.
- s. No additional lighting or power installed in the Centre without the prior approval of the Operator. All electrical equipment must be tagged by a certified electrician.
- t. It is the responsibility of each individual entering the Centre to take care of their own personal belongings. The Trust takes no responsibility for any theft of personal items.
- u. The school grounds may not be accessed at any time by any persons. The Facility Manager reserves the right to stop any activity that disrupts or interrupts school activities, and may ask the person or group to leave.
- v. Any behaviour which is considered improper or disorderly will be acted upon and the person may be asked to leave.
- w. In the case of serious offences or criminal activity police will be notified. The Facility Manager reserves the right to issue a trespass notice and refuse entry in the future.
- x. In the event security, or emergency services are required, the hirer may be charged for any associated costs
